COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Under the NSW Government Guidelines for Places of Worship the following conditions of entry must be published.

The auditorium of the Macquarie Church of Christ at Kent Road, North Ryde can accommodate 39 people under the 4 square metre per person rule.

Members and visitors who wish to attend the Sunday service at 10.45am are required to have their names placed on a roster which will be published each Friday night via email. It is important that if your name is not on the roster, you do not attend. (Contact: sklempfner@gmail.com).

Members or visitors are required to use hand sanitiser upon entry. Masks will be provided and are recommended.

Members and visitors are required to maintain a physical distance of 1.5 metres from one another at all times (with the exception of those from family groups). Please follow this Government requirement to save embarrassment to those who will have to remind you.

Parents are required to ensure that their children understand the need for social distancing and that they are practising it.

People should not congregate around the entrances/exits.

When outside the building it is a requirement to continue to practise social distancing.

If driving a person not a member of your household, please take measures to ensure you minimise close contact with passengers.

You must not attend the church premises if you develop a fever, cough, sore or scratchy throat or shortness of breath.

Recommended

You are encouraged to download the COVID-19Safe app to assist in contact tracing.

Masks will be available and you are requested to use them.

There will be no access to the kitchen area other than to the person in charge of preparing the Lord's Supper. Members are requested to bring their own water bottles.

It is recommended that use of the toilets be kept to a minimum. When entering and exiting the toilets please be careful to comply with social distancing rules.

Air conditioning will not be used so please dress according to the weather conditions.
